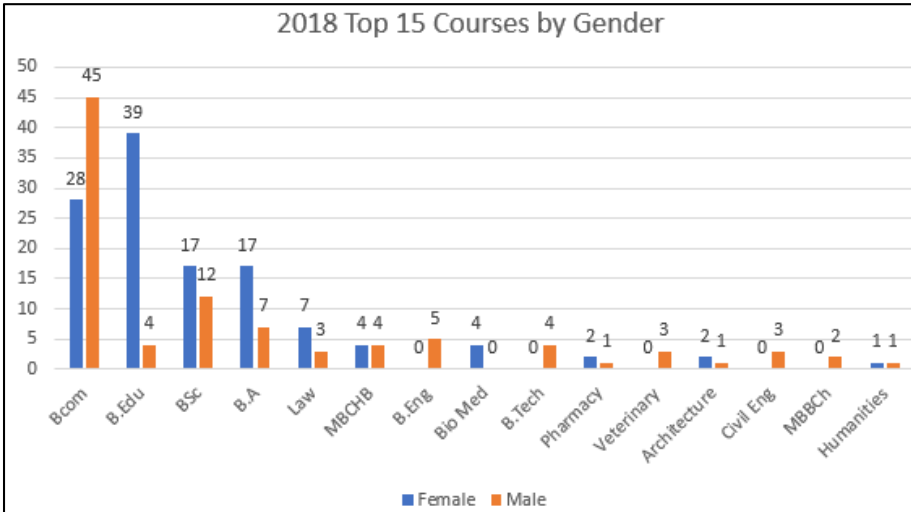

2019 BURSARIES GRANTED

The Association is currently providing financial assistance to **207** students for the 2019 academic year.

More than **R7,000,000** has been disbursed or committed for the 2019 academic year.

Some interesting numbers from our 2019 bursaries:

- 56 are new and 152 are renewal students.
- 122 are female and 85 are male.

THE GRADUATES

that have completed their studies since 1965.

The earning potential of these graduates is at least R400 million per annum. This is more than what the Association has paid out since its inception.

These graduates have:

- become financially independent,
- helped uplift their families and younger siblings,
- paid their South African taxes and also contribute Zakaat to various organisations, including the Memon Association.
- become dignified and confident leaders and help enhance the community.

We humbly request that graduates volunteer to assist the Association in any way.

2018 Graduates

Some interesting facts about the graduates from 2018.

- 45 students graduated in the 2018 academic year. The majority of the

graduates are from Tukkies (18 Graduates), 8 from Unisa and 6 from Wits.

- 26 Female graduates and 19 male graduates.
- It took students an average of four years to graduate with a total cost of R 97,000 over the 4 years

 - ✓ Law (4 students)
- The Memon Association paid R4,361,505 in fees for the 45 students who graduated in 2018.

BURSARY APPLICATION

We ask students and parents to please follow the rules set out in the application form to assist in the timeous processing of applications.

We would like to remind students that bursaries are **NOT** automatically granted each year.

All applicants, new and renewals NEED TO APPLY EVERY YEAR for an application form.

If a student does not apply for a renewal bursary, we will assume that the student no longer requires a bursary.

Students must please submit their **WRITTEN** requests for an application form for a **NEW** or a **RENEWAL** bursary to applications@memonsa.co.za

The request for the application form should clearly state the full name of the student. Every application form that is sent out will have a **UNIQUE FILE NUMBER**.

Please apply for the bursary on time and follow all instructions to avoid unnecessary delays.

- The **UNIQUE file number** issued to all applicants becomes the student's permanent reference in all matters.
- All supporting documents have to be provided together with the relevant administration fee before the application is processed.
- Each application is assessed individually and the decision is made collectively by the Bursary Committee.

Completed forms for **NEW** and **RENEWAL** applications **must be signed** by the student, the parent/guardian, and a Regional Member and must reach us by no later than 15 January 2020.

APPLICATION PROBLEMS

Below are some of the difficulties the Bursary Committee has faced in processing applications this year:

- Many applications are not properly and fully completed.
- Forms are being submitted well after the deadline.
- Forms are given by students to individual Associations members or other persons instead of being sent directly to the Secretary, as instructed on the form.
- Applicants do not pay the Administration fee
- The file number given to a student is not used a reference number when communicating with the Association.

18A Income Tax Deduction

The Memon Association of South Africa is a **registered Non-Profit Organisation (NPO)**. Your donations to the Association can qualify as an income tax deduction. If you require a **Section 18A Tax Certificate** to claim the deduction from your taxable income, please contact our office.

Please provide us with the **NAME** (e.g. personal name or company name) and **ADDRESS** of the person to whom we should issue the 18A receipt.

It should be the same name as in your Income Tax return.

THE NATIONAL STUDENT FINANCIAL AID SCHEME FUND (NSFAS)

This is a government bursary fund known as the DHET Bursary Scheme.

The aim of this scheme is to provide free higher education and training for poor and working class South Africans.

The fund pays out to 26 Universities and 50 TVET colleges.

Student from families earning less than R350 000 per annum qualify for this scheme.

In order to maintain a bursary, the student needs to continuously pass all subject of the course.

Should a student wish to study at a TVET college, a Grade 9 or Grade 10 pass is sufficient to qualify for the scheme.

The scheme pays for tuition, accommodation and also provides the student with a monthly allowance of R275.

Once a student has been approved by the fund there is no re-application process for the following year due to the fact that, a students' financial needs are assessed only once at the initial application.

The Memon Association of the Transvaal (now of South Africa) was started in September 1965 by a group of Memon businessmen from Fordsborg and Vrededorp.

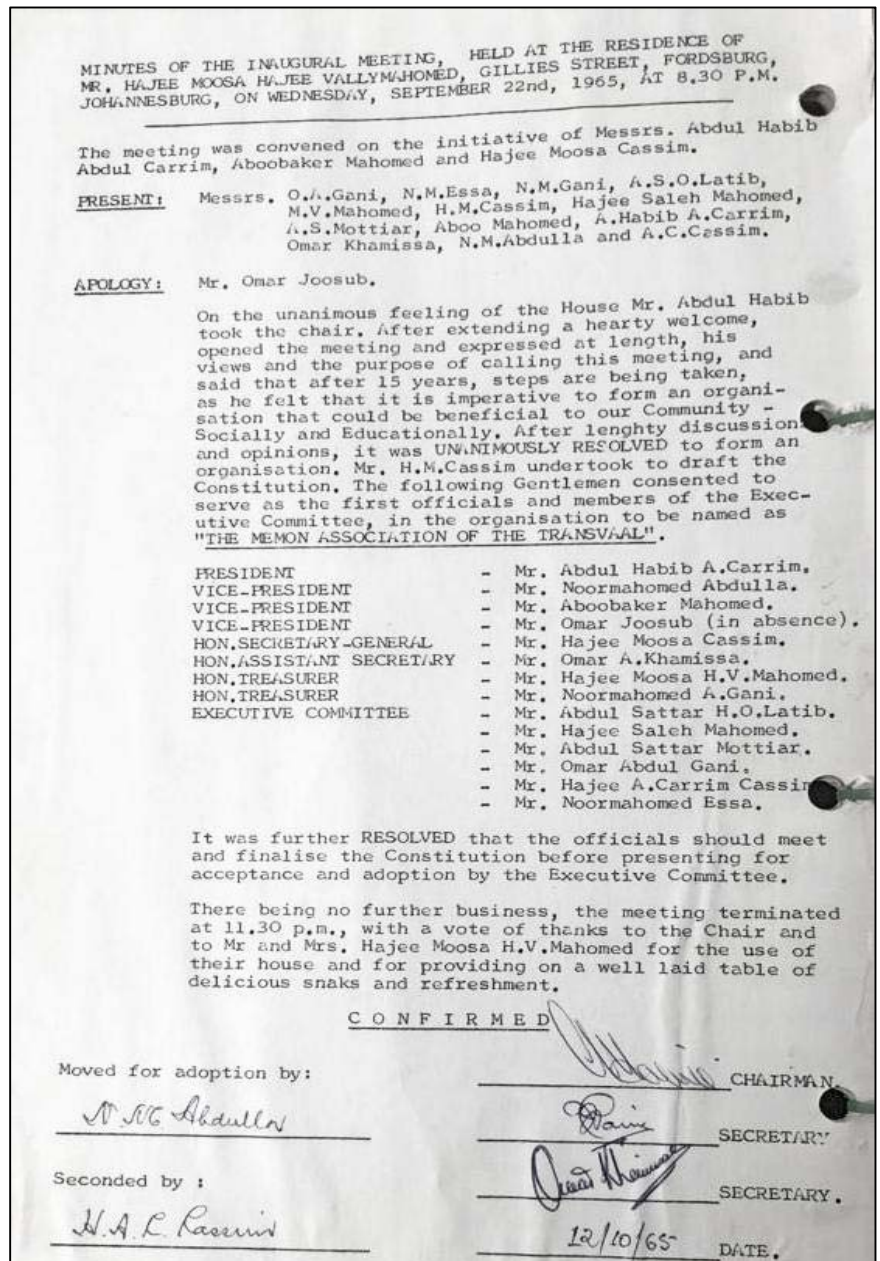
Most had hardly finished high school, but the professionalism they brought to the Association from Day 1 can be illustrated by these First Minutes of the Exco.
